



The Dairy Spares Cow Lifting Net is the quick sure way to get a 'Downer' cow on its feet.

You will find it necessary to have :

1. Cord for tying off the net along the animals back.
2. A strong pole or pipe to put along the net to give it an even lift.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Fig 1.

Either use the blue rope to pull the net through from the underside of the animal, (red ropes to the back end), or roll the animal over on to the net.



# The Cow Lifting Net From Dairy Spares

Fit the net as snugly as possible around the animal and tie off along the back with the cord.

### Fig2.

The red ropes are brought along either side of the udder. (Ensure you keep the udder clear of the net). Tie into the net above the tail head.



The yellow ropes are taken through the front legs and taken over the shoulder and tied into the net.

### N.B.

Neither the red or Yellow ropes are used for lifting.



### Fig 3.

Put your strong pole along and through the net. This will ensure an even strain when the animal is lifted.

The animal is now ready to be lifted. Manoeuvre the front loader forks through and under the pole and lift gently.



- The Dairy Spares Net can be used to lift recumbent animals.
- Put onto an animal before being made recumbent
- Left on the animal if necessary
- The Dairy Spares Net is very strong and will lift most farm livestock
- Can be washed in a washing machine
