

Milk Bar™ Teat Cap for Retro Fit to Peach Teat Feeders













- 1. Unscrew the existing cap and Peach teat from the feeder.
- 2. Clean around the feeder thread and orifice.
- 3. Ensure the washer is fully inserted in the Milk Bar® Cap.
- 4. Place the Milk Bar[™] teat through the cap hole so you can hold it securely while the Milk Bar[®] Cap is screwed back onto the feeder. *Do not pull the teat fully through the cap at this stage.*
- 5. Tighten the Milk Bar™ Cap to the feeder so it will not loosen during use.









- 6. Examine the Milk Bar™ Teat end and rotate the teat to ensure the slit is vertical.
- 7. Pull the Milk Bar™ Teat through the cap until it seats securely into its groove.
- 8. Check the back of the Milk Bar™ teat to ensure the straight section of the teat is horizontal.
- 9. It is advisable to periodically check the cap is secure and the teat is correctly positioned.

Important - Cleaning Milk Bar™ Teats



- · After each use, rinse with warm water.
- Three times a week, wash with alkali-based detergent in warm water.
- Wash the outside of the teat by using a horizontal scrubbing action with a brush.
- Rinse with fresh water to finish.
