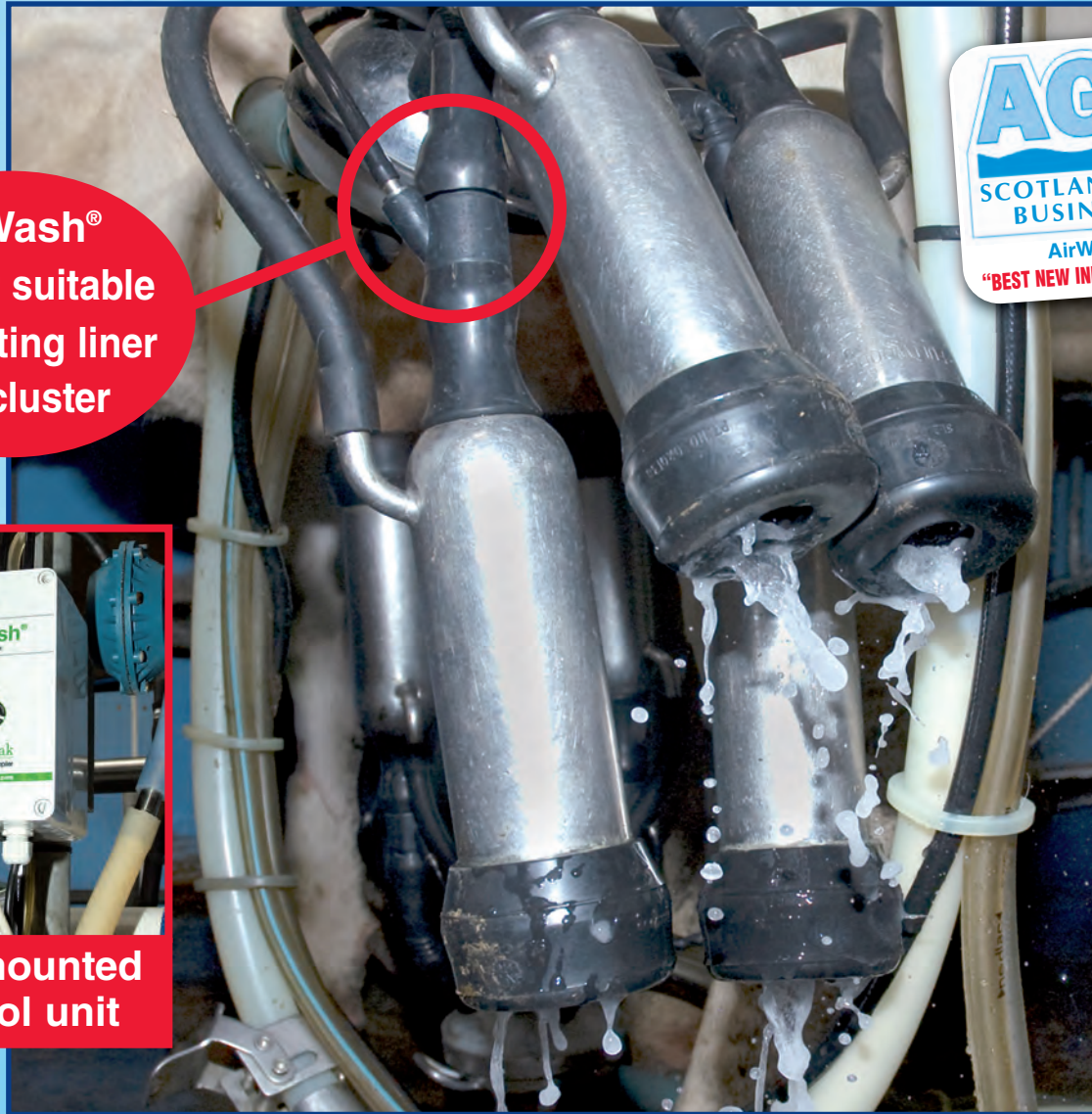

OBJECTIVE OF AirWash[®]

Features	Benefits
Can be fitted to existing clusters.	No change in liner costs, does not affect milking technique.
On removal of cluster, liners are flushed with water and chemical then purged with compressed air.	Provides consistent wash for all four liners, using 400-500ml water for each cow.
Mains or bore hole water fed via filter to a holding tank and pumped under pressure to parlour.	Easy and convenient to install, large loft tank not required. System provides clean filtered water on every wash.
